**ACADEMIC AWARDS**

Mabton School District annually recognizes student academic achievement. The valedictorian and salutatorian awards are an example. Students competing for such awards are expected to excel on a comparative basis. Therefore, the District has determined that when recognizing outstanding academic achievement for the valedictorian and salutatorian awards the students, in order to qualify for such awards, must have a minimum enrollment of two full nine month school years at Mabton High School and a minimum of 50% of the grade point average (GPA) credits must be earned through completed coursework at Mabton High School. The superintendent has the authority to examine awards on a case by case basis.
